

Poster Session – Invitation to Participate



As part of the “Rethinking the Futures of Mediterranean Land and Water” a Poster Session will be organised on 11 September to showcase scientific results, field experiences, and innovative approaches related to the event’s themes. Up to 15 posters will be displayed. The SALAM-MED, AG-WaMED, OURMED, Gen4MED, NATMed, and SurePastor are invited to use the suggested template below, while the other projects, a degree of flexibility is permitted, including the possibility to reuse posters previously presented at other conferences. The composition of the posters is expected to reflect both scientific results and social and political impacts. The traditional format is A0 (approximately 85 × 120 cm, vertical orientation). The session will provide an opportunity for networking and knowledge exchange among project partners and stakeholders.

Submission Procedure

Participants are requested to:

1. **Upload the posters** to the designated [SharePoint folder](#);
2. **Complete the Excel file** by indicating the organisation responsible for the poster and a brief description of its main contents (2–3 lines).

This information will be used to monitor the total number of posters and ensure that it remains consistent with the room capacity. The Excel file should be completed as soon as possible and no later than **31 October 2025**. The upload of posters may take place after that date.

Exhibition Setup and Logistics

As agreed with the Academy of Athens, it is recommended that the exhibition room be set up by 10 November to ensure a smooth organisation on the day of the event. Each participant is responsible for printing and bringing their own poster.

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4. Youth and Women (Empowerment)

This section should illustrate how the project has invested in human capital and inclusiveness.

- **Empowerment:** description of how the project contributed to enhancing autonomy or participation in decision-making.
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5. Contact Details and Final Message

- **Main Message (Take-Home Message):** a concise statement summarising the project's main outcome or impact
- **Contact:** email of the project coordinator and/or link to the project website
